

Our Mission . . .

The Free State Project is an agreement among 20,000 pro-liberty activists to move to New Hampshire, where they will exert the fullest practical effort toward the creation of a society in which the maximum role of government is the protection of life, liberty, and property. The success of the Project would likely entail reductions in taxation and regulation, reforms at all levels of government, to expand individual rights and free markets, and a restoration of constitutional federalism, demonstrating the benefits of liberty to the rest of the nation and the world.



The **Free State Project** is made up of ordinary libertarians who have pledged to come together and make a real difference.

The Free State Project is NOT a political action organization. It is not tied to any political party. It does not run candidates for election, and it does not financially support or endorse candidates. It neither opposes nor endorses legislation.

New Hampshire, The Free State

When the Free State Project reached 5,000 commitments, a vote was conducted to select the destination state from a field of ten candidates. On October 1, 2003 we announced that our participants had chosen New Hampshire as the future Free State.

New Hampshire's small population factored heavily in the selection process. Our research showed that 20,000 activists can heavily influence states, like New Hampshire, with populations of less than 1.5 million and our early movers report that even a few hundred can make a significant difference. With its existing distaste for big government and a welcoming attitude for the Free State Project's goals, it is an attractive destination. Migrating FSP participants will find a state rated in 2004 and 2005 the safest and most livable in the country.

New Hampshire's State Motto:

“Live Free or Die”.

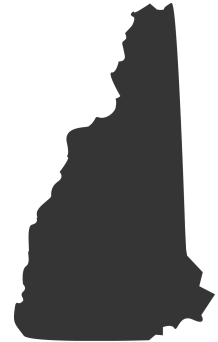

Participation Guidelines

- 1) The **Free State Project (FSP)** shall not require dues or contributions of any kind for participation.
- 2) The **FSP** shall require all prospective participants to sign a Statement of Intent (Statement) indicating:
 - a) that they will move to New Hampshire, the state designated according to the rules laid out in these Guidelines.
 - b) that they will be bound by the Guidelines, and
 - c) that they will work toward a society in which the sole role of civil government is the protection of life, liberty, and property.
- 3) Once 5,000 people had signed the Statement, and in accordance with the original Participation Guidelines, voting commenced on a state where all participants should move and register to vote (should they choose to register to vote). New Hampshire was chosen. The voting was conducted according to Simple Condorcet's Method.
- 4) Once 20,000 people have signed the Statement, participants in the FSP shall move to New Hampshire as expeditiously as possible, and absolutely within five years of the crossing of the 20,000-signer threshold. Should the Project never attract 20,000 signers, the move shall be aborted.
- 5) If these Guidelines are amended, anyone who has signed to an earlier version shall be given the opportunity to withdraw his consent.
